What is the Georgia Youth Summit?

The Georgia Youth Summit is a statewide event designed to create an awareness of state/local issues, to enhance youth-adult partnerships on the local level, and to equip youth to become active locally in the betterment of their communities by identifying problems and developing solutions for issues related to economic development, education, health and safety. The Department of Community Affairs (DCA) provides funding for the Summit as a project of the Georgia Rural Development Council's Youth Leadership Initiative.

What is the Role of the Planning Committee?

The planning committee is composed of a diverse group of youth and adults from around Georgia. They will help with planning, coordinating and evaluating the Summit.

What is Required of Planning Committee Members?

Planning committee members will be expected to attend the following meetings at the Rock Eagle 4-H Center in Eatonton, GA:

- Planning meeting 1: Evening of **February 27th**– to afternoon of **February 28th, 2010**.
- Planning meeting 2: Evening of **June 26th** to afternoon of **June 27th, 2010**.
(Other than Current State 4-H Officers, there should be no conflicts with State 4-H Council Activities.)
- Planning meeting 3: Evening of **August 7th** – to afternoon of **August 8th, 2010**.
- The 2010 Georgia Youth Summit – The evening of **September 10th through the afternoon of September 13th, 2010**.
- Participate in periodic conference calls and contribute to group assignments throughout the planning process. Summit coordinators will take into consideration the busy schedules of youth participants and will be sure not to over load Planning Committee Members.

Participants must provide their own transportation to and from events, but they will be reimbursed for mileage.

All meals and lodging will be covered at all planning meetings and the Youth Summit itself. Lodging and meals can be provided for adult chaperones if needed.

Adult Chaperones must complete the UGA Volunteer Screening Process. There is no cost to the volunteer.
